## **What the Bible Teaches Us About God's Glorious Works**

- God's manifest works testify of his deity.

*Known unto God are his works from the beginning of the world.* (Acts 15:18, KJV)

*For You are great and do marvellous deeds, you are alone are God.* (Psalm 86:10, NKJV)

Romans 1:20, John 14:11

- The Lord God is unmatched and unrivalled in all of his marvellous deeds.

*To Him who alone does great wonders.*  
(Psalm 136:4, NKJV)

*Who among the gods is like you, LORD? Who is like you-majestic in holiness, awesome in glory, working wonders?* (Exodus 15:11, NIV)

- God triumphs over all of his enemies through his awesome works.

*Come, behold the works of the LORD, who has made the desolations in the earth.*  
(Psalm 46:8, NKJV)

- God's glorious works overrides all catastrophes and adversities upon the earth.

*He makes wars cease to the end of the earth; He breaks the bow and cuts the spear into two; He burns the chariot in fire.* (Psalm 46:9, NKJV)

- God's judgement is a work of his glory. (Isaiah 66:18)
- There is no work that is too hard for God to accomplish on our behalf.

*Ah, Sovereign LORD, you have made the heavens and the earth by your great power and outstretched arm. Nothing is too hard for you.*  
(Jeremiah 32:17, NIV)

*For nothing will be impossible with God.*  
(Luke 1:37, CSB)

*I will even make even make a road in the wilderness, and rivers in the dessert.*

- The Lord's mighty works go far beyond all human comprehension. (Job 9:10, Romans 11:33)
- Nothing can limit God from carrying out his mighty works. (1 Samuel 14:6) *Nothing can stop God from saving by many or by few.* (Revelation 3:8, Job 42:2)
- God's glorious works reveal his sovereign goodness over our lives. (Romans 8:28, Philippians 2:13)
- God's perfect timing accompany and complement his glorious works. (Ecclesiastes 3:11, Galatians 4:4)
- God is diverse in the way He carries out his wondrous works. (Ecclesiastes 11:3, 1 Corinthians 12:6)
- Believers are a continual work in process with the Lord. (Philippians 1:6, 2 Corinthians 3:18)

**Deliverance For the Children of Israel**

The Exodus:

Deuteronomy 4:32-35

- The Crossing of the River Jordan:

*For the LORD your God dried up the Jordan before you until you had crossed over. The LORD your God did to the Jordan what he had done to the Red Sea...* (Joshua 4:23, NIV)

God made the sun to stand still. (Joshua 10:13-1)

- The earthly ministry works of Jesus Christ.

*Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves.* (John 14:11, NKJV)

*How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.* (Acts 10:38, NKJV)

2. Set the captives free. (Luke 4:18, John 8:36)
3. Destroyed the works of the evil one. (1 John 3:8, Matthew 8:16)
4. Forgave sins. (Matthew 9:5-6, Luke 7:36-50, John 8:11)
5. Healed the sick. (Matthew 9:35, Luke 4:40)
6. Raised the Dead. (Luke 7:11-17, Luke 8:40-56, John 11:38-44)
7. Supernaturally Provided for His Disciples. (Matthew 14:13-21, Matthew 15:32-39)
8. Accomplished The Work of Salvation Upon the Cross at Calvary. (1 Peter 2:24, Isaiah 53:4, John 19:30)

- The Work of the Holy Spirit in the Early Church. (Acts 2:1-4; 4:28-31; 9:31; 10:44; 19:6)

**What Does God's Glorious Working Power Mean to Me?**

1. I will recall the great things that He has done for me. (Psalm 77:11, Psalm 105:5)
2. I can trust the Lord to come through for me in times of great difficulty. (Isaiah 43:16)
3. I will render the glory and praise to God for all the great things He has done. (Psalm 92:4-5)
4. I will speak of the Lord's glorious deeds. (Psalm 105:1-2)
5. I will make myself available as a vessel for God to extend His mighty works through my life. (John 14:12, 2 Timothy 2:21, Daniel 11:32)
6. I need to be fully committed and connected to God's masterpiece the local church. (Matthew 16:18)
7. I can expect the best is yet to still come for God to work in my life.
